

Privacy Policy

This privacy is effective as of 2025-02-25.

At Opti Core Limited, we've created this Privacy Policy to clarify how we collect, use, disclose, and handle personal information in connection with our business operations. This policy outlines our practices regarding the information we gather through our websites and mobile applications where this Privacy Policy is posted.

This Privacy Policy applies to our websites, mobile apps, and any other online services that feature this policy, as well as our collection of information through our social media pages and features (each referred to as a "Service" and collectively as the "Services"). In addition to detailing how we manage personal information, this policy explains the rights and options individuals have regarding their personal data.

We may also provide additional privacy notices when we collect your data. These "in-time" notices will outline how we handle the information you provide at that time.

GENERAL ISSUES REGARDING THE MOBILE APPLICATION AND SERVICES

Applicability of Terms and Conditions: Your use of any Services and/or the Mobile Application, as well as any Redemptions, is governed by these Terms and Conditions of Use.

Scope: The Mobile Application, Services, and any Redemptions are intended solely for your personal, non-commercial use and may not be utilized for business purposes.

Right to Restrict Use: We reserve the right to restrict your access to the Mobile Application and Services (or any part thereof) and to prevent you from making any Redemptions.

Equipment and Networks: The provision of Services and the Mobile Application does not include the supply of a mobile phone, handheld device, or any other necessary equipment to access the Mobile Application or Services or to make Redemptions. To use the Mobile Application or Services, or to make Redemptions, you need an internet connection and suitable telecommunication links. You acknowledge that your agreement with your mobile network provider ("Mobile Provider") remains in effect while using the Mobile Application. Therefore, you may incur charges from your Mobile Provider for accessing network services during your connection to the Mobile Application, as well as any third-party charges that may occur. You are responsible for any such charges.

Permission to Use Mobile Application: If you are not the bill payer for the mobile phone or handheld device you are using to access the Mobile Application, you are assumed to have

License to Use Submitted Material: By submitting any text or images (including photographs) ("Material") through the Application, you confirm that you either own the Material or have the necessary authorization from the owner to use, reproduce, and distribute it. You grant us a worldwide, royalty-free, non-exclusive license to use the Material for promotional purposes related to any products or services.

INFORMATION WE COLLECT

The Privacy Policy delineates the parameters for data collection and handling protocols as they apply to all users of our services across the globe. This includes but is not limited to individuals accessing our mobile applications, official online platforms, or related offerings (collectively referred to as “the Service”), except where specifically stated that alternative privacy provisions or additional conditions to this policy are in force. It is imperative that you scrutinize this Privacy Policy meticulously, together with any ancillary privacy statements or information processing directives that might be provided during particular interactions, to gain a thorough appreciation of the context, objectives, and techniques driving our procurement and treatment of your personal data. - (c) We will retain personal information only as long as necessary to fulfill those purposes.
- (d) We will collect personal information through lawful and fair means and, when appropriate, with the knowledge or consent of the individual involved.
- (e) Personal information should be relevant to the intended purposes, and, to the extent necessary, should be accurate, complete, and up-to-date.
- (f) We will safeguard personal information with reasonable security measures against loss or theft, as well as unauthorized access, disclosure, copying, use, or modification.

We are committed to conducting our business in line with these principles to ensure that the confidentiality of personal information is protected and maintained.

When using our Service, we may ask you to provide certain personally identifiable information, such as IDFA, IDFV, and Advertising ID. This information will be stored on your device and will not be collected by us.

Legal, Regulatory, Compliance, and Similar Reasons

We may also disclose and share your information to comply with legal or regulatory requirements, such as court orders, subpoenas, and industry standards. This includes protecting against and responding to fraud, illegal activities (like hacking incidents), adverse event reporting, and other liabilities.

We may disclose your information when we believe, in good faith, that it is necessary to:

- Take precautions against liability.
- Protect our rights, property, or the rights of others.
- Investigate and defend against third-party claims or allegations.

Additionally, we may collect, use, and disclose your personal information as required or permitted by law, or as directed by you, in line with this Privacy Policy.

Do Not Track Disclosures

Some web browsers may send "do-not-track" (DNT) signals to the websites you visit. Due to differences in how browsers implement this feature, it is often unclear whether users intend to send these signals or are even aware of them. Currently, there is no industry standard for how websites should respond to DNT signals, so our sites do not process or respond to these settings.
